



- Take the B4371 heading towards Church Stretton for 9 miles, passing through the village of Longville in the Dale (past the Longville Arms).

- Stay on the B4371 until you reach the small village of Wall-under-Heywood.

- In the village turn LEFT off the main road (on a sharp bend in road, by the phone box and bus shelter), sign posted *Rushbury, Beambridge and Darby Lane*. (If you reach the Plough Pub you've just missed the turn).

- Stay on the Darby Lane and go out of the village (do not turn off this lane).

**The Darby Lane is a narrow single track country lane with passing places, it is not wide enough for 2 cars to pass each other.**

**Please drive slowly and be prepared to stop.**

**You may need to reverse to the nearest passing place to let on-coming traffic pass.**

- Keep following the lane for almost 2 miles (going past Boystone Farm on your left, and past The Saplings and Whitefields Farm on your right).

- At the very end of the lane, you pass Pendennis on your left, and then come to a T junction

At the T junction turn LEFT, and follow the road down the hill over the little bridge at the bottom of the valley, bearing RIGHT by the Church and along the concrete drive.

The Office – Eaton Manor is on the RIGHT (after The Manor House and Curlew Cottage).
