

Swimming Pool Regulations

There is no lifeguard on duty in this swimming pool. Anyone using the pool needs to take responsibility for their own safety, and follow the regulations set out below:

The pool is available during daylight hours only, please book your slot via the Calendly link sent to the lead booking person.

On entering the swimming pool building, familiarise yourself with the pool layout.

Guests are prohibited from using the swimming pool unaccompanied. Children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult at all times.

If the swimming pool cover is in place on your arrival, please ensure the cover is removed using the specialist cover roller provided.

On no account should anyone swim under the pool cover or attempt to go on top of the pool cover when it is on top of the water.

Flooring around the pool can become slippery and wet; do not run around the pool area.

Take care of uneven surfaces and obstacles around the pool, particularly the steps into the pool building and into the pool water and drainage channels.

Diving or jumping into the pool is prohibited.

Do not swim in the pool if the water is unclear. If you cannot see the bottom of the pool or to report a fault please ring the Eaton Manor office on 01694 724814 immediately. The pool is checked daily by a member of the Eaton Manor team.

Guests are not permitted to smoke, eat or drink in the pool, surround or building. Avoid swimming immediately after eating or when under the influence of alcohol.

The swimming pool building is locked for safety. Please lock the building upon departure.
